Alive at 25 Defensive Driving Course

Instructors discuss techniques to cope with peer pressure, passengers, distractions, cell phones and driving hazards in a classroom setting. This course is used in many states by schools for parking permits, insurance companies for driver discounts, courts for first infractions and employers to address their younger employees' decisions and habits behind the wheel.

Proven to significantly reduce crashes, citations and DUI arrests

- Some insurance companies will give up to a 15 percent discount upon completion of the class.
- This course meets Maryland MVA requirements for those that are under age 25 and required to attend a Driver Improvement Course.
- Attendees must be on time and should bring MVA paperwork with them if assigned by Court to take a DIP course.
- Certificates will be mailed upon completion of the course.
