



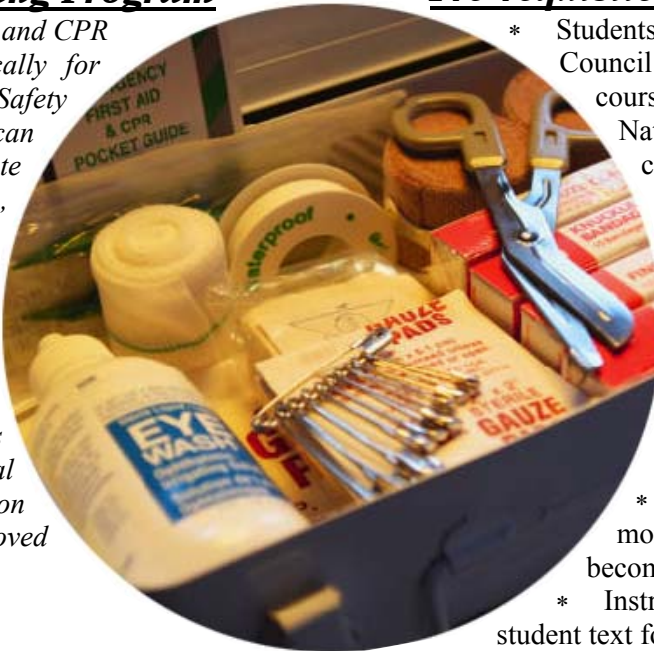
EMERGENCY CARE PROGRAMS

- * Instructor credentials must be renewed annually
