

SAFETY TRAINING METHODS

(STM) focuses on the knowledge and skills required to plan, organize create and deliver effective training programs. Participants repeatedly comment that they find themselves much more comfortable before a group by the end of this course with new skills that improve both confidence and effectiveness.

THE ADVANCED SAFETY CERTIFICATE (ASC) is the National Safety Council's program for development of safety professionals. Those who earn it can be justifiably proud of their accomplishment. It places them a cut above the others in the field and tells their top management that they are better able to develop and implement an effective safety and health program. The ASC targets skills that increase compliance with regulatory standards, improve productivity and enhance employee participation in the safety and health process. Those who earn the ASC are better able to provide other employees in training needed to make a safety and health program work, and fulfill their responsibilities as part of management.
